Why am I Thankful for Job's Daughters

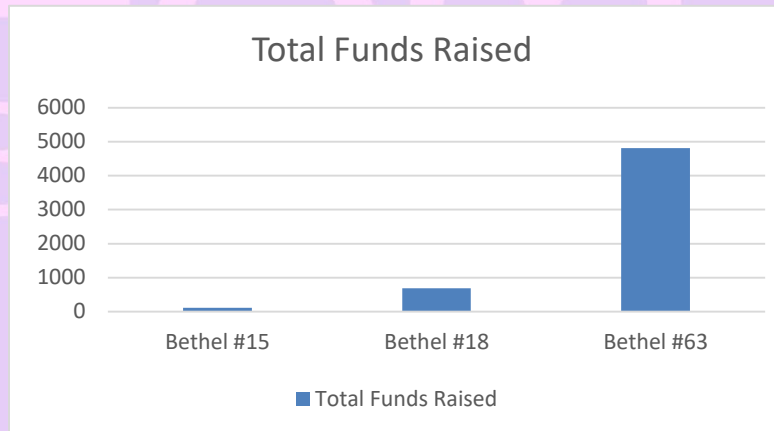
