

Grand Librarian's Competition 2018

All Nebraska Job's Daughters, Majority Members/Adults are encouraged to participate in the Grand Librarian's competitions! We have removed a few categories so please read over them carefully! Hopefully there is a competition that appeals to everyone! This is a great way to express yourself using your creative side. This year's theme, "Dream Big, Sparkle More, Shine Bright" will be utilized in each category.

Feel free to enter any of the competitions for which you qualify!

Rules for each category:

1. Mail three (3) copies of each entry, unless you are submitting via e-mail. If you are submitting via e-mail, please make sure each entry is formatted into a Word Doc or a PDF.
2. Entrants may participate in one (1) or all of the competitions for which they qualify.
3. The name of entrant and their Bethel/city should NOT appear anywhere on any of the entries submitted.
4. Entries must be postmarked on or by May 1st, 2018. Entries submitted after this postmark date will still be included, but will receive a 10 point deduction.

Category: New Member Essay

Entrant: Any daughter who has been initiated since Grand Session 2017. Age categories will be determined based on the number of entries.

Theme: We all have big dreams. As a member of Job's Daughters, what dreams do you have for your Bethel? Who will you ask for help to achieve those dreams? How will you be a part of making those dreams come true?

Maximum Length/Requirements: No more than three (3) pages typed, double-spaced, using size 12 Times New Roman or Arial font.

Category: Essay

Entrant: Ages 10-12, ages 13-15, and ages 16-20

Theme: Don't tell people your dreams, show them! One of the greatest gifts that God has given us is the power to achieve our dreams. This often seems impossible, but with the help of our Job's Daughters family we can achieve anything. Tell us about a time that your Bethel has worked together to make a dream come true (this could be a HIKE Presentation, fundraising event, installation, initiation, prospective member event, etc.) How did it make you feel? How did it make others around you feel?

Maximum Length/Requirements: No more than three (3) pages typed, double-spaced, using size 12 Times New Roman or Arial font.

Category: Majority Member/Adult Essay

Entrant: Majority Members/Adults

Theme: "All of our dreams can come true, if we have the courage to pursue them." Walt Disney obviously knew what he was talking about as it would have taken a great amount of courage to pursue his dreams. One of the great joys of adult leadership in Job's Daughters is helping young ladies find the courage to achieve their dreams. Another great joy is seeing the excitement in a daughters eyes as she sees her dreams come true. Give us an example of a time you have seen this happen. As an adult leader, how do you help encourage your daughters to pursue their dreams? How does it make you feel when you daughters have achieved their dreams?

Maximum Length/Requirements: No more than three (3) pages typed, double-spaced, using size 12 Times New Roman or Arial font.

Category: Poetry

Entrant: Ages 10-12, ages 13-15, ages 16-20

Theme: Write any kind of poem, utilizing the Grand Themes "Dream Big, Sparkle More, Shine Bright" or "If you can dream it, you can do it." Alternatively, you may write about anything Job's Daughters related.

Maximum Length/Requirements: No more than three (3) pages typed, double-spaced, using size 12 Times New Roman or Arial font.

Category: Creative Writing

Entrant: Ages 10-12, ages 13-15, ages 16-20

Theme: Write a short story utilizing the Grand Themes "Dream Big, Sparkle More, Shine Bright" or "If you can dream it, you can do it." Alternatively, you may write about anything Job's Daughters related.

Maximum Length/Requirements: No more than three (3) pages typed, double-spaced, using size 12 Times New Roman or Arial font.
